Notice is hereby given that the City of West Memphis, Arkansas is seeking letters of interest from qualified consulting firms for engineering related services for the Arkansas Highway and Transportation Department (AHTD) Job No 110676, South Loop Extension (West Memphis) (S) in West Memphis, Arkansas.

The work will generally consist of providing environmental studies and documentation, Geotechnical studies, hydraulic studies, roadway, bridge and drainage structures design, plans and specifications, right-of-way determinations for acquisition from Scope of Work, and right-of-way plans for construction of approximately 12,000 L.F. of South Loop Road Extension from Port Road west to South Airport Road, which shall conform to the requirements of the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and AHTD.

This project includes Federal STBGP GT 200K Attributable funds with local match and all work will be reviewed and approved by the AHTD.
